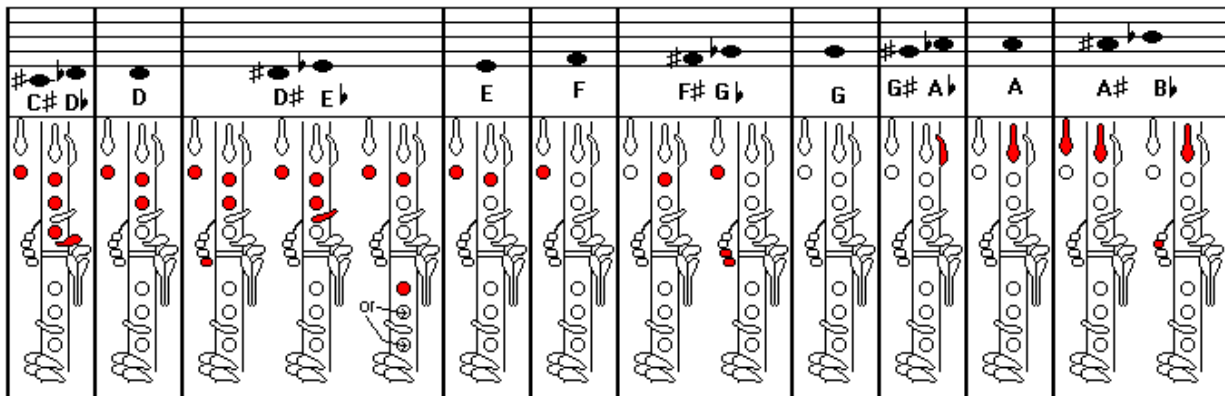
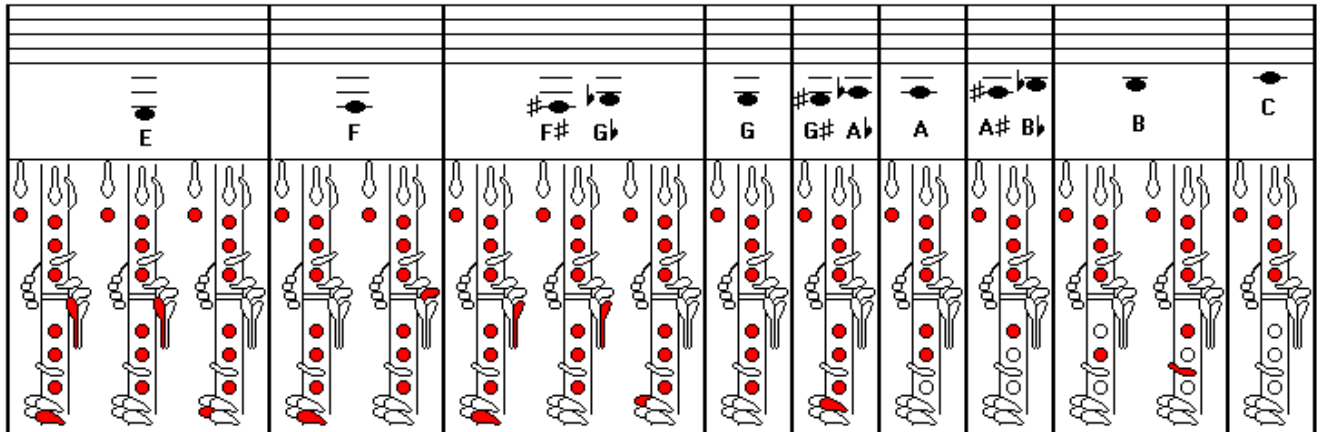

Notes are from q to l and Q to K with qwerty keyboard.

Search ClarinetTab font at the bottom or in plugins.



## Doigté de Clarinette
